

Committee of Foreign Affairs: Iran Bill

Proposal:

- Offer Iran an ultimatum.
 - Allow UN delegation full access to all Iran sites, including ones in undisclosed location
 - Any militaristic aspect of the Iranian nuclear program must be shut down immediately by the UN, with Israeli supervision
 - Accept a limit on the amount of radioactive, nuclear weaponizable materials in Iran, to be enforced by the UN with Israeli supervision
- Failure to meet the ultimatum:
 - Immediately upon rejection of aforementioned ultimatum, harsh economic sanctions will be placed upon Iran, including but not limited to raised tariffs and refusal of Iran goods from the international market.
 - One week following the rejection of the ultimatum, all economic relations with Iran will be severed.
 - If refusal persists past one month, Israel will launch a military strike against targets deemed appropriate to strike, including, but not limited to uranium enrichment facilities and military bases
- Global support
 - While we hope that the global community recognizes the threat of a nuclear Iran and is willing to back Israel economically and militarily in the endeavor, Israel will continue with the ultimatum and repercussions for the rejection of the ultimatum regardless of global support

Reasoning:

- Iran has stated numerous times that they want to destroy Israel
- We face destruction if they attain a nuclear weapon and must do all in our power to prevent this
- If they continue, without any interference, their nuclear program will soon be so far underground that we will no longer be able to successfully destroy it
- We have strong evidence that they are currently moving towards attaining a nuclear weapon and will soon be armed with weapons of mass destruction
- We have a responsibility and obligation to defend our citizens, our land, and this place that we have fought and risked our lives for
- War is the last option. We do not want to risk Israeli lives. However, the threat of a nuclear armed Iran is a threat to everyone, and we must do what we can to prevent it
- We will not stand idly by while they taunt us
