

Equitable Funding For All Schools

The Israeli government values education. We believe that every child deserves to be in a supportive, advanced, and innovative learning environment. When we invest in education, we believe that we are investing in the future. Thus, it is our utmost priority to make sure that the children of Israel are raised to become productive members of society. In addition, when financially supporting schools, we need to be sure that we are supporting institutions whose values align with the State of Israel's (the State of Israel's values being based in Zionist and Jewish ideology).

Public schools receive 100% of their funding from the Israeli government. Private schools can receive up to 75% of their funding by meeting the following criteria:

- A private school must teach Zionist ideology and or Jewish religious material
- A school must not, under any circumstance, teach anti-Zionist ideology

These restrictions on government funding and distribution criteria will be applied to all current and future private institutions (regardless of their religious orientation or lack thereof).

If a school teaches anti-Zionist ideology, the school will NOT receive any funding from the Israeli government.
