Step 1) **Each person will research their role:**

Step 2) Peer edit:

Once you have completed your part of the report (the three paragraphs you wrote answering the questions) you will peer edit with your group using the Peer Edit Checklist on page ____ .

Step 3) Sharing your written report with the class:

Work with your group to decide if you will be using a prezi, powerpoint, poster, etc. to present your information to the class. You must include "suggestion time" into your presentation. Suggestion time will be a time during your presentation where the audience can give you ideas for your fair presentation.

Step 4) Final fair presentation:

The next step of this report is to prepare a creative station for your group to present and teach your research to another audience (another grade or class).
