You will be presenting your report in the form of a fair. Your group will get a space/station where you can set up your interactive space.

Your goal is to show, in a creative way, how your role helps to create a functioning colony.

Your station must include:

- 1) Dressing up in clothing connected to your role as a Pilgrim or Puritan
 - a) Example: Look up images of how the people in your role looked at that time. You can make a hat out of construction paper and a skirt out of tablecloth.
- 2) An interactive piece relating to your role that a visitor to your station can try
 - a) Example: Sign a document with a feather pen, create a game from that time for visitors to play, let visitors knead dough...
- 3) Visual decorations that relate and teach your report information.
 - a) Example: A sample menu from the time, a list of laws from the time period, directions for a game played...
- 4) Include your classroom presentation (prezi, powerpoint, poster...) in your station.
