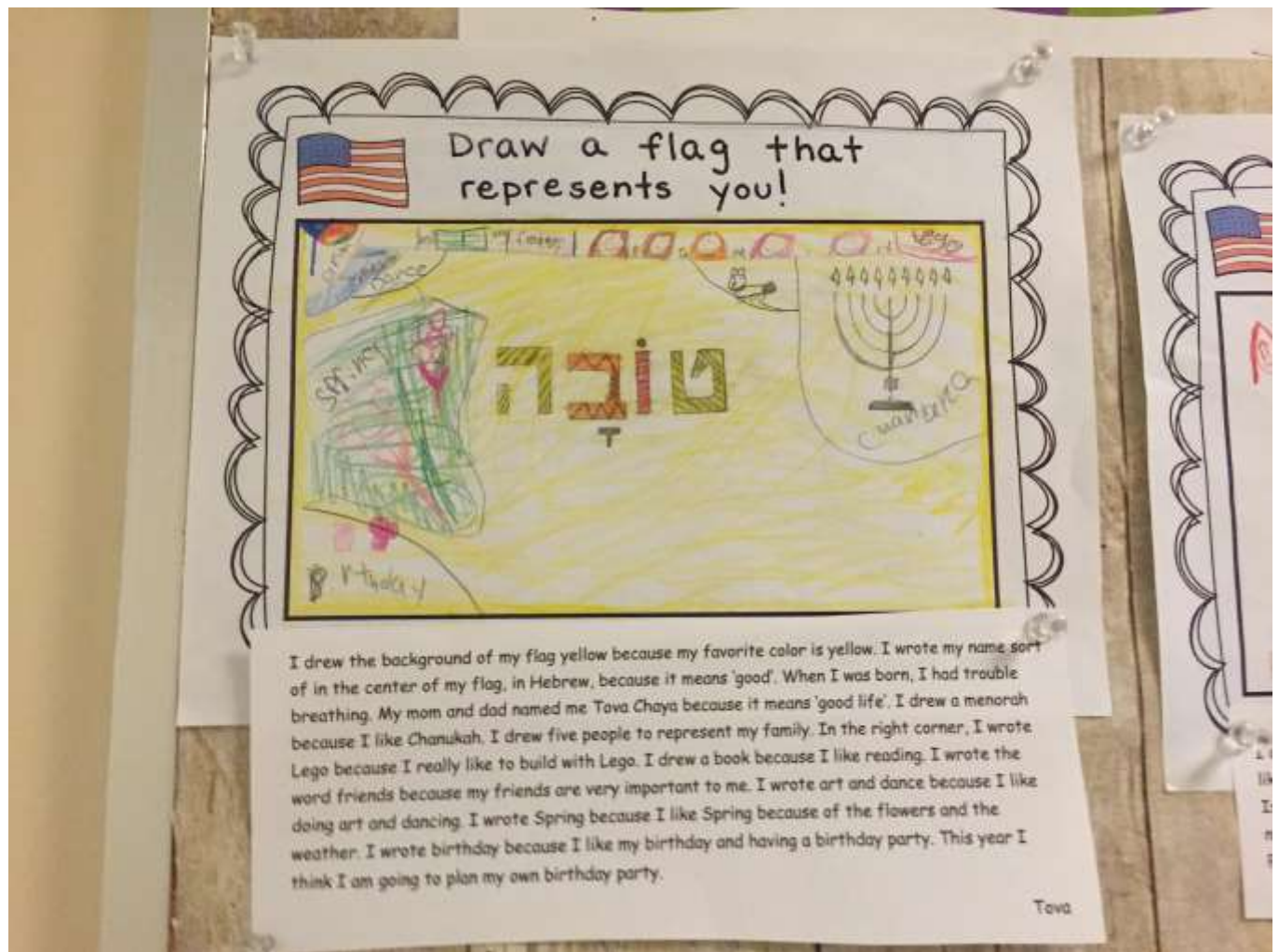


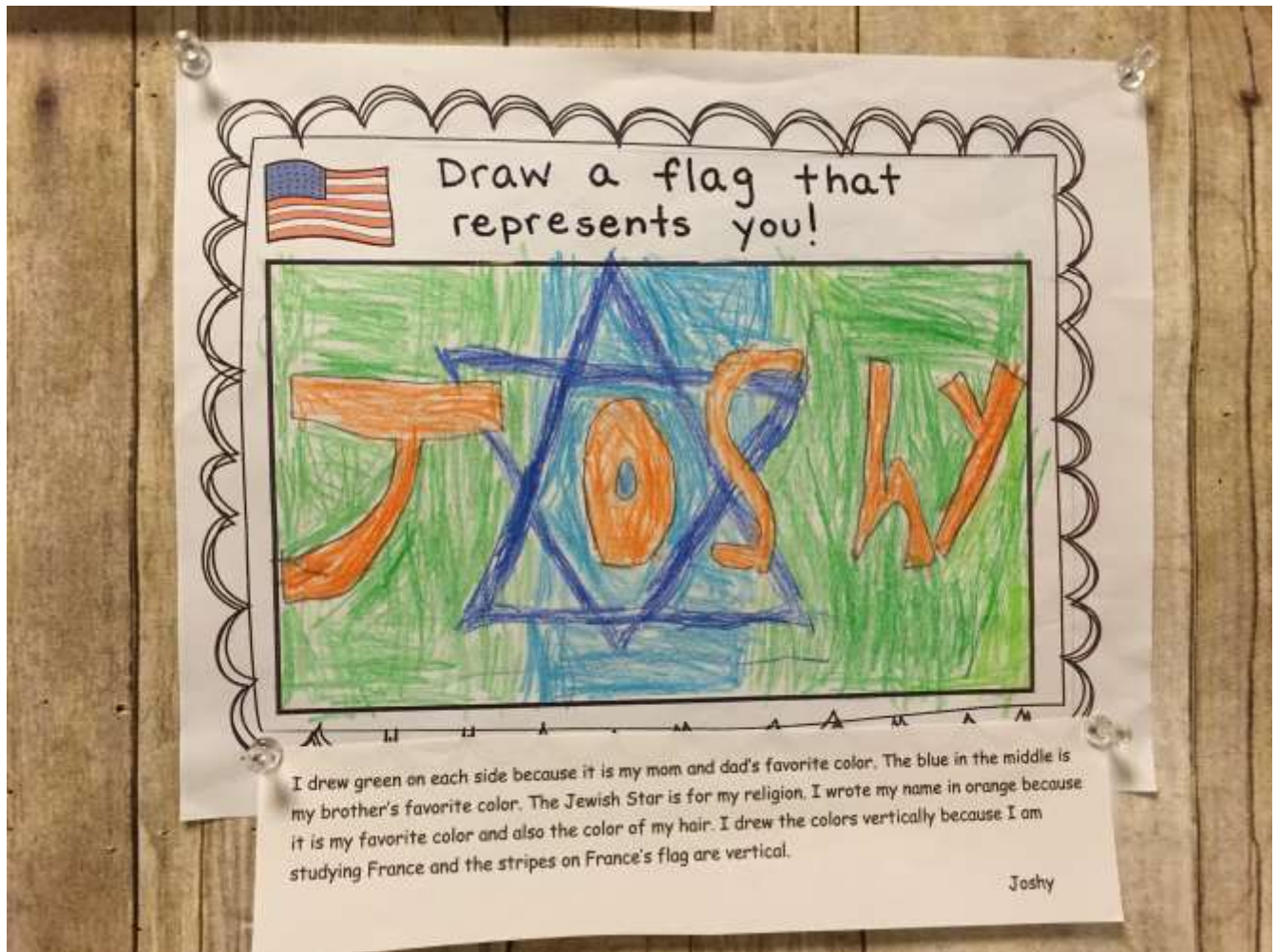
Lower Elementary Personal Flag Extension Activity – Examples of Student Work



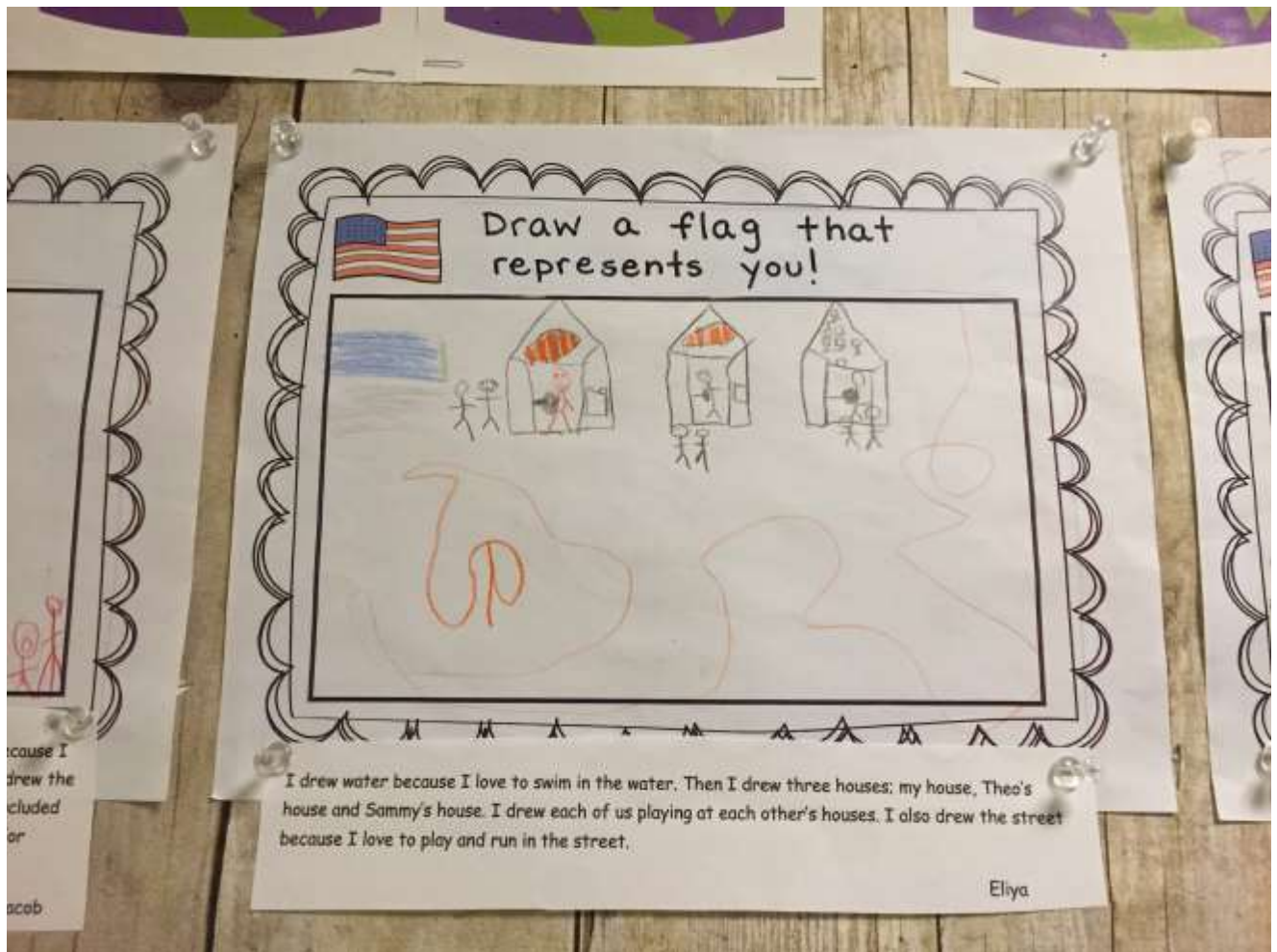
The beautiful student work became a bulletin board outside our classroom as a way to really get to know the Lower Elementary students in our classroom.

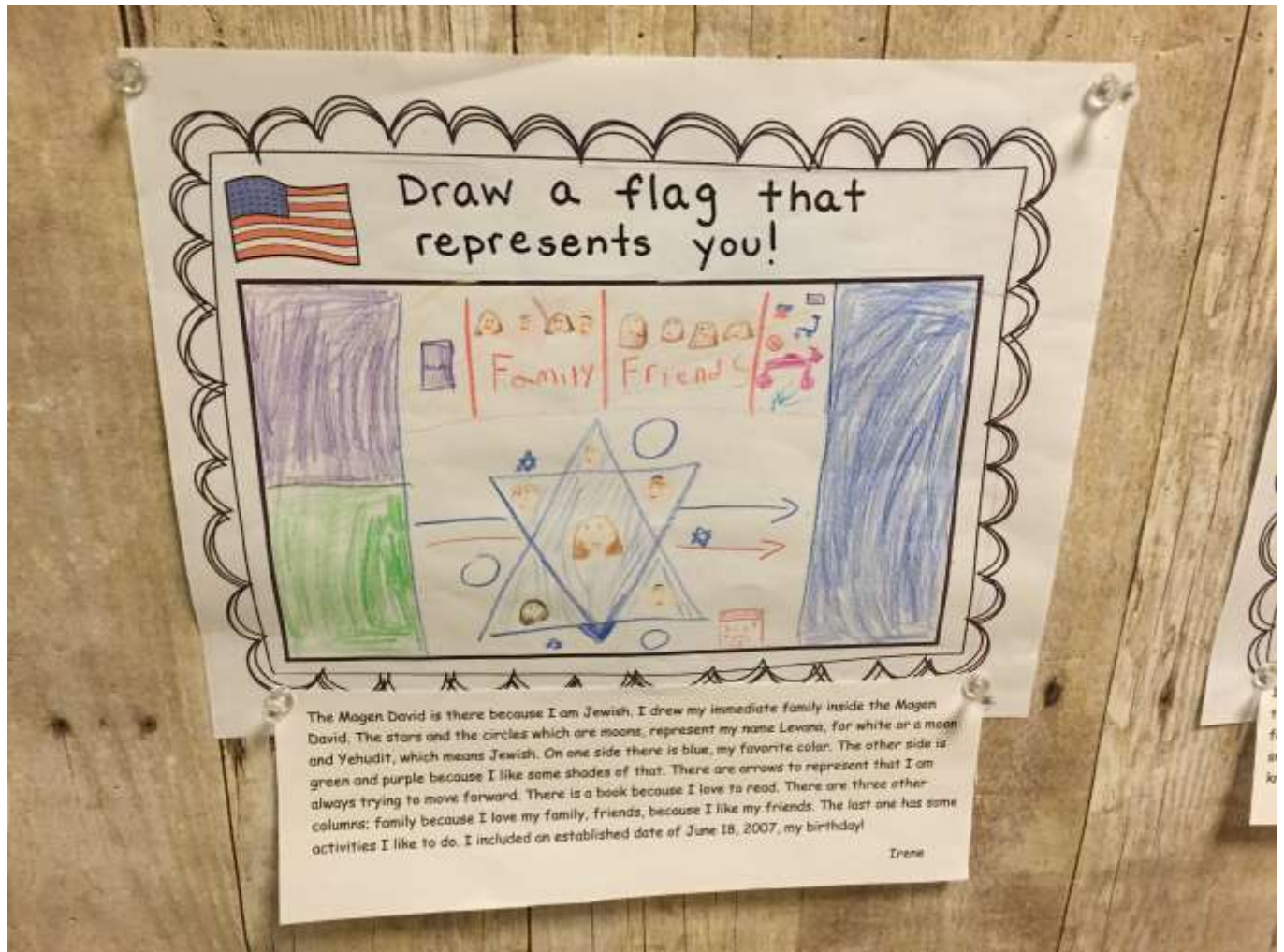

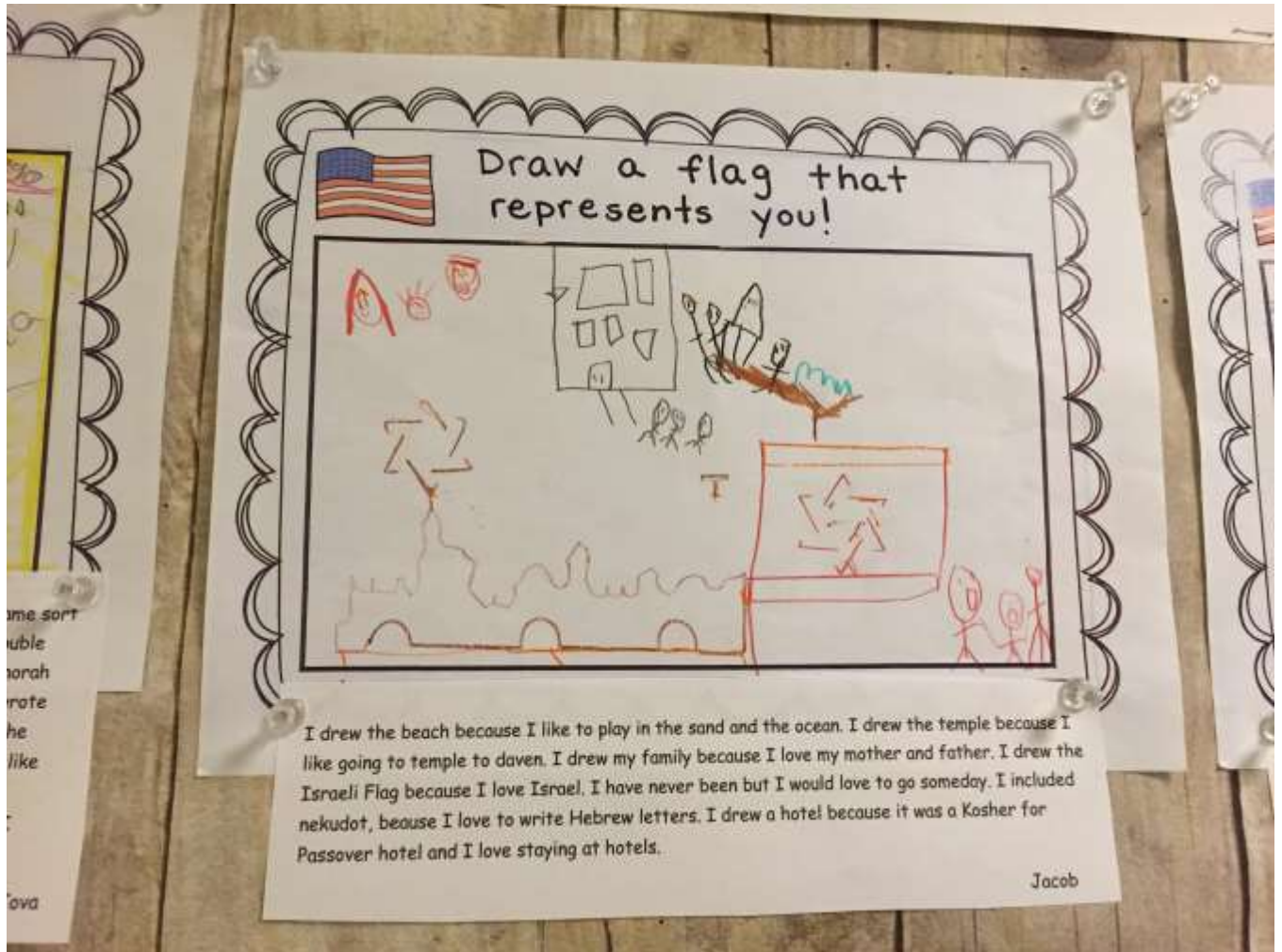
Eliya, First Grade
