(Friends, community members, campers, younger siblings, students, children etc!)

Why is it important to be open about the good things that you do?

(- of course not in a way that is "show-offy"...!)

*Story of man who learned so much Torah, but children didn't follow in his ways because he only
learned in privacy behind a closed door...*

Did you know that your parents do so much for the community!? Maybe you have no
idea because so much of their activities take place while you're in school! Ask them to
involve you so you can learn from their good deeds!
