Grade 3 Chai Celebration Project

In Grade 3, students looked at passions as the impetus that drives one's dreams. Each student chose a topic related to a personal passion, and then formulated a research question. Students developed a plan and then implemented it, managing their time throughout this project in order to be prepared for classroom presentation dates.

Students researched their topics online, in personal interviews and by reading non-fiction texts. Once the research was complete, students prepared in-class presentations. Some used Powerpoint, Prezi or Popplet as ways to present information in engaging ways. As part of the presentation, each student incorporated an activity for students to complete that taught them about the passion. For example, a student who was passionate about basketball brought students to the gym to have them all participate in basketball drills for skill development. Each student was also responsible for creating a presentation board outlining the research, which was then displayed at the Grandparents' and Special Friends' event.
