

Sukkah Prototype Presentations

Each group will present their prototype Sukkah to a panel on Monday, September 19 at 2:30. The panel's job is to evaluate each prototype and make a recommendation to the class as to which Sukkah design we should actually build.

Here are the requirements of your presentation:

- I. Each presentation should answer the following questions:
 - Why did you chose to prototype this particular design?
 - How did you choose to prototype (ie, cardboard, 3D print, etc.), and why?
 - What are the Sukkah's dimensions, and what scale did you use to create a smaller scale prototype?
 - What (if anything) about your design would probably be the hardest part to actually build?
 - Why should the panel select your prototype?

- II. Your presentation must include a description of the prototype building process, including documentation of the process such as photos of your progress along the way.

- III. Your presentation should be no more than four minutes long.

You should expect members of the panel to ask you questions after you present.

Presentations will be in the Ideation Studio. You may use Google Slides or any other technology for your presentation.
