Why Korach deserved his punishment:

- talking bad about Moshe/ rebelling against g-d
- ulterior motive= jealous
- knew Hashem chose Moshe
 - 1) saw all / miracles Moshe did in Egypt
 - 2) saw / Miriam/ tzara'at
- lied to get people on his side / didn't plan to give leadership to everyone/ was really just jealous
- influenced neighbors= Datan & Aviram → sin/ against Hashem (just to gain his own power)
- already Levi/ had special job/ Mishkan / just wanted more power + Kehunah

D & A deserved to die b/c:

- rebelled against Hashem + Moshe
 - Rashi: big egos/ disrespectful/ tried curse Hashem + attack Moshe
- Hashem saved them / took out of Egypt
