A powerful scene in Yirmiyahu (Jeremiah) is when Yirmiyahu goes to visit the potter's house. And Hashem tells him a Nevuah (prophecy) based on the potter crafting a clay vessel. All the 10th grade classes learn this Nevuah and the 10th grade teachers envisioned a program where the students can actually experience that on their own, crafting their own clay vessels. This year, we did this program before Yom Kippur because one of the highlights of Yom Kippur after we say Kol Nidrei, we say the piyyut KaChomer BeYad HaYotzer Ken Anachnu BeYadcha, like Clay in the Hands of the Potter so are we in Your hands Hashem. So, the students are able to draw from their learning of Yirmiyahu and they're able to draw from their experience in making a clay vessel to understand what it means to be molded by a potter.
