## **FAQS**

### What is the relationship between Ashira and Ateres Bais Yaakov?

Ashira is an independent educational program hosted on the Ateres campus. The Ateres- Ashira partnership creates an environment in which students are able to learn and grow from each other. This partnership facilitates mainstreaming of Ashira student in Ateres' programs and classrooms, while providing Ateres students with an opportunity to be active partners with Ashira students. The administration of both Ateres and Ashira are involved in the Ashira admissions process.

### How many girls are in each Ashira class?

As a self-contained program, Ashira class sizes are kept to a maximum of 12 students per class, with the support of a paraprofessional in the classroom.

### What qualifications do Ashira's teachers hold?

All teachers are qualified special education teachers holding Masters degrees in this area with multiple years of classroom experience.

## Is Ashira accredited, and can my daughter receive a high school diploma?

The Ashira Program functions under the Ateres Bais Yaakov umbrella. Girls in the Ashira program can take advantage of Ateres' accreditation as an officially chartered New York State Board of Regents School. Ashira students who meet the standards of graduation requirements will receive a high school diploma. Students also have the opportunity to earn a New York State Regents diploma. Local diplomas and Hebrew diplomas are also offered.

### For which classes are the students able to join the general education environment?

Students have the opportunity to mainstream for all non-academic subjects. In addition, students can mainstream for academic classes on an individual basis depending on levels of academic proficiency and functionality.

## Are Ashira students able to be part of Ateres extracurricular activities and other special events?

Absolutely! Ashira students participate in the Shabbatons, school trips, chessed projects, and all other extracurricular activities that are part of the Ateres campus life.
