מָאָרַיִם asked מָאָרַיִם. Rashi teaches us that a kindness that people do for a person who died, is a "מָּצֶרִים" - a kindness of truth, because it is not a kindness where one expects to get any benefit from the person who died. When you help or go out of your way to do a favor for someone, do you expect them to help you or do you a favor for you at a later time? Do they really owe you one? Does it mean only doing a favor if it's easy to do? When was the last time you did a מְמִילִּוֹת חָסָדִים?
