

What is Inquiry Based Learning?

- IBL places students' questions, ideas and observations at the centre of the learning experience.
- Educators play an active role in moving children from a position of wondering to a position of understanding and further questioning. (Scardamalia, 2002).
- Founded on the principal that both educators and students share responsibility for learning.

What is Inquiry Based Learning?

- It begins with student created open-ended investigations into a question or a problem.
- ♦ It continues with the students needing to investigate and work with evidence-based reasoning to find the answer to their question.


Benefits of Inquiry Based Learning
